

ERP*i* Service-Disabled Veterans Scholarship

If you are a service-disabled veteran, we invite you to apply for the ERP*i* Service-Disabled Veterans Scholarship. The scholarship supports academic achievement and professional development of service-disabled veterans who become undergraduate or graduate students in the School of Policy, Government, and International Affairs (SPGIA) at Mason.

AWARD LEVEL

This scholarship is awarded in the amount of up to \$2,500 per semester for the duration of the recipient's program (*after other funding support has been applied*).

ELIGIBILITY

Students admitted to one of SPGIA's two undergraduate or nine master's programs—who are defined as service-disabled by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs—are eligible to apply for this award. Other criteria considered include financial need, academic achievement, and a demonstrated interest in public service.

SPGIA programs of study include Biodefense, Government and International Politics, International Commerce and Policy, International Security, Organization Development and Knowledge Management, Peace Operations, Political Science, Public Administration, Public Policy, and Transportation Policy, Operation, and Logistics.
