

ERP*i* Service-Disabled Veterans Scholarship

If you are a veteran or a dependent of a service-disabled veteran, we invite you to apply for the ERP*i* Service-Disabled Veterans Scholarship. The scholarship supports academic achievement and professional development of veterans and dependents of service-disabled veterans who become undergraduate or graduate students in the Schar School of Policy, Government Mason.

AWARD LEVEL

Scholarship recipients receive up to \$2,500 per semester toward educational expenses, after other funding has been applied, for the duration of their program. Recipients are also eligible to pursue an internship for academic credit and receive a \$5,000 internship stipend.

ELIGIBILITY

All veterans admitted to a Schar degree program are eligible to apply. Dependents of service disabled veterans are also eligible to apply. Priority consideration is given to veterans with a service-disability ranking. Other criteria considered include financial need, academic achievement, and a demonstrated interest in public service.

Programs include Government and international Politics, Biodefense, International Commerce and Policy, International Security, Organization Development and Knowledge Management, Peace Operations, Political Science, Public Administration, Public Policy, and Transportation Policy, Operations, and Logistics.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES
