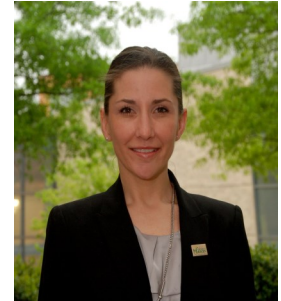

New In- State Tuition Legislation

With the new legislation implanted by the state of Virginia, both the registrar's office and admission are becoming overloaded with processing requests and information for students. Please remember, they are working as quickly and diligently as they can.

Keep in mind that before your domicile decision can be changed for our veteran students, you must first have an initial domicile decision. **That is, you will have needed to submit an application for in state tuition with your application.** This can be found at the following link. <http://registrar.gmu.edu/students/domicile/under> **Application for In – State Tuition Rates.** Please submit all supporting documents with this application.

Tuition Refunds

Students, from now on will no longer be receiving reimbursement for funds from student accounts and financial aid until all tuition is paid in full. What this means is until all payments have come in whether from TA, the VA, or another means of financial aid, you do not have available funds. You cannot be paid based off of a memo put on your student account. This also means there is only a small window in which you can have funds reimbursed. Once you have registered for the following semester, there is the possibility of having your funds act towards your next semester's tuition balance.

Maximizing Your GI Bill Benefits

Rounding Out

Students using Post 9/11 GI Bill benefits can 'round out' a schedule with non-required courses to bring their course load up to full-time for purposes of receiving BAH. This allows students to continue to receive benefits at the full-time rate in their last semester, even though fewer credits are required to complete the program.

Students may use ANY class (for credit), including a class that has been taken and passed previously.

*Please write in the comments box of your VRRF (Veterans Registration Reporting Form) that you would like courses to be certified under **Rounding Out**.

Conditions

- Student MUST be full-time during semester for VA to cover non-required courses. If a student is less than full-time, VA will not consider it rounding out.
- Must be the students FINAL semester in that program, and have applied for graduation.
- Rounding Out can only be done ONCE per degree program.
